fabric to cut it from. **GRAIN LINE:** This double pointed arrow dictates the placement of the template on

dictates the placement of the template on the fabric – ensure that it lays parallel to the grain of the fabric. FOLD LINE: This arrow indicates the

placement of a pattern piece along a fold. Make sure that it is pushed right up against the fold of the fabric. Fabric Preparation

It is advisable to launder your fabric before use in the same way as you would the finished project. This will ensure any dye running or shrinking occurs before you cut out the pieces.

Once laundered, press the fabric with a warm iron to neaten, ready for pinning.
We advise laying your fabric right sides up, so that you can choose how to lay the pieces to accommodate any motif.
